COUNTY ACTION REQUESTED ON: Relocation of gate, utility pole, and light pole at Val-tech pump station, and Quit-Claim Deed to GDOT

HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: In connection with its widening of Shiloh Rd., the GA Dept. of Transportation requests a Quit-Claim Deed from the County covering land it does not own but on which it has 2 utility easements including for an existing pump station. The 2 utility easements are excluded under the Quit-Claim Deed. GDOT is also requesting the County to relocate the entry gate, a utility pole, and a light pole at the Val-tech pump station. These relocations are to occur within 30 days after the Commission's approval of the transaction, the 30 days to complete relocations, and the Quit-Claim Deed. GDOT will pay the County \$8,000.


OPTIONS: 1. Approve transaction, 30 days to complete the relocations, and Quit-Claim Deed and authorize the Chairman to sign same.
