HISTORY, FACTS, AND ISSUES: The former Wisenbaker/Amoco Service Station is located directly behind the Administration Building at 327 N. Ashley St. The site has been up and running since 2007. Lowndes County has to report quarterly and semi-annually to the Georgia EPD and the system has to be maintained on an on-going basis. AECOM installed the system, monitors the system, and has completed all the reports since installation. AECOM is currently working with the EPD on new guidance from the Georgia Underground Storage Tank Management Program on pending issuance that would enable a risk-based closure to the site. Once the new EPD guidance is issued, AECOM will discuss the alternative for closure strategy with Lowndes County. In the meantime AECOM will continue to meet the regulatory requirement of continued groundwater monitoring and remediation system operation in accordance with the Corrective Action Plan – Part B (CAP-B).
