Resolutions Imposing 911 Charges for Wireless Services, County Manager, Joe Pritchard presented the resolutions. Mr. Pritchard stated that due to a timeline recently announced by the State of Georgia, a special called meeting was scheduled to give the Commission an opportunity to consider the resolutions prior to the deadline. Mr. Pritchard stated the resolutions have been reviewed by staff and County Attorney, Walter Elliott, adding approval will allow the County to continue to collect wireless 911 charges. Commissioner Wisenbaker asked if there is a system in place to account for collections at the state level to ensure allocations are appropriate. Mr. Pritchard stated that staff will be monitoring disbursements as they are received. Vice Chairman Orenstein made a motion to approve the resolutions as presented, Commissioner Griner second.
