COUNTY ACTION REQUESTED ON: Acceptance of FY2024 Juvenile Justice Delinquency Prevention Grant

HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: On July 25, 2023, the Board of Commissioners authorized staff to submit a request for continuation funding as part of the Delinquency Prevention Grant. This is the grant program which was originally funded beginning in April 2022 for the implementation of evidence-based programs and prevention strategies for youth who are first-time offenders, diverted from the juvenile justice system, or charged with a status offense and identified as at risk. This funding was used to implement the Strengthening Families Program.

Lowndes County was recently notified that we have been awarded \$50,000.00 in continuation funding to be used to continue the Strengthening Families Program (SFP). This amount will allow for the provision of services to at least two (2) cohorts of SFP, an increase over the single cohort provided with the initial funding. Each cohort is a minimum of eight (8), and a maximum of twelve (12), youth and their families. During the past grant year, between October 1, 2022 and September 30, 2023, there were a total of 21 youth who successfully graduated from the SFP program.

The Strengthening Families Program (SFP) is an evidence-based family skills training program for high-risk and general population families that is recognized both nationally and internationally. Parents and youth attend weekly SFP skills classes together, learning parenting skills and youth life and refusal skills. They have separate class training for parents and youth the first hour, followed by a joint family practice session in the second hour.

#### COUNTY ACTION REQUESTED ON: LAS Generator

HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: The generator at the Land Application System (LAS) needs to be upgraded in order to run the aerators in the treatment ponds. The generator there now is not sized to handle this and will be relocated to the Val Tech lift station. Currently, the lead time for generators is 12-15 months, and there have been two price increases in the past 12 months. Cowart Electric has a 100kw generator scheduled to be delivered in December and the customer has canceled the order. The price of this unit is \$48,068.00. We requested quotes from two additional vendors, Cummins Sales & Service for \$54,225.99 and Davis Industrial Electric for \$60,800.00. Due to availability and price, staff recommends purchasing the 100kw generator from Cowart Electric for \$48,068.00.

### COUNTY ACTION REQUESTED ON: Resolution Approving Reissuance

HISTORY, FACTS AND ISSUES: The Board of Commissioners approved Refunding Revenue Anticipation Certificates issued by the Hospital Authority in 2019. The Authority is now planning to lease the hospital facilities financed or refinanced by the 2019 Certificates to a new corporation named South Georgia Medical Center, Inc.

The Internal Revenue Code and Treasury Regulations treat the proposed lease as a reissuance of the 2019 Certificates which must be approved by the Board of Commissioners since the facilities financed or refinanced by the 2019 Certificates are located in the County.

A proposed Resolution is attached. It approves the reissuance of the 2019 Certificates and the Authority's leasing the financed or refinanced facilities to South Georgia Medical Center, Inc. Notice to the County of a related public hearing is also attached.
